#### Summary:

At 1328 hours on May 7 Norfolk Southern Railroad reported telephonically that at 0530 hours on May 6, tampered rail property was discovered at the 63rd Street yard on the Englewood Intermodal Subdivision, Chicago, IL. Two cars were missing their seals, one with a load of mixed freight and the other with a load of firearms. After an inventory of both cars, it was discovered that the load of firearms was short 13 rifles. Norfolk Southern notified the Chicago branch of the ATF and is also conducting an internal investigation. There was no impact to operations. At the time of this report, there was no media attention. TSOC notified DHS and MDW TSA.

each pallet, was 25 cases of .308 caliber Winchester ammunition, each case containing 25 boxes. This was at Park Manor Yard at mile post 513.5 on the Chicago Line at 7100 South Cottage Grove Road, Chicago, IL. This is primarily a freight line. Norfolk Southern Special Agents responded, removed the pallets, and confiscated the ammunition. LEOs conducted a sweep of the area with negative results. Norfolk Southern notified Chicago Police and ATF. The shipping label on the boxes determined the ammunition was being shipped to Cabela's Sporting Goods in West Virginia. There was no impact to freight rail operations. At the time of this report, there was no media attention. TSOC notified DHS-OIA.
